



Tickets are available at Tix.com (Keyword: Lanikuhonua) for \$20. Or for \$25 at the door. Keiki six years and under are free. Food and beverages (including beer and wine) will be available for purchase. Please note that no outside food, drinks or high back chairs will be allowed.

Mele & Hula has become a popular event, drawing an average of 400 concertgoers per concert since it began. Past concerts have featured such headliners as Amy Hanaiali'i, Ledward Ka'apana, Raiatea Helm, and Kapena. Kimo Keaulana has been a returning artist for four out of the five Mele & Hula concerts.
