





- the City of Kapolei and the Kapolei-Campbell Industrial Parks help to sustain State economic activity, as was the case in the Great Recession
- Supporting areas include East Kapolei residential areas, Ko Olina and Kalaeloa



Kapolei Infrastructure: Supporting Growth

- Major regional infrastructure supporting industrial development completed over the last several years
- Kapolei Interchange Ph. 2 opening in February 2020; Ph. 3 is being readied as the next phase of this public-private partnership with DOT
- Kalaeloa Harbor plays a significant part in the State's industrial and logistics infrastructure









Key Upcoming Projects: Kapolei Harborside Industrial

- 360-acre industrial project are is the largest developing industrial area in the State
- Will accommodate the next 15-20 years buildout of modern industrial and logistics services
- First phase of infrastructure underway



Key Upcoming Projects: City of Kapolei Mixed Use

- Focused on new project development on mixed use blocks extending through the Civic Center
- City and County of Honolulu has made some progress on its 34 acres of lands
- Hale Moena apartment mixed use project (297 units) is nearing completion



Key Active Projects: Mokulani at Kapolei

- Property development is complete; Project development is ongoing
- BMW-Mini of Hawaii dealership and service is under construction
- 808 Carwash/Aloha Gas will be open early 2021
- Lots 3, 4, 8 available for lease



Hope and Reality Through a Tough Winter & Into 2021



- Hawai'i currently has the lowest per capita
 COVID cases in the U.S.
- Vaccines are on the relatively near horizon
- Prospects for additional Federal stimulus
- Some U.S. economic improvement could translate to more visitors
- Hawai'i visitor arrivals up 23% in November
- More flights are being added in December, including from Canada and Japan
- Hawai'i bankruptcy filings are declining
- Hawai'i new unemployment claims have been stable since October
- The real estate market is performing well

- Crisis level of new mainland and international COVID cases, including in primary Hawai'i visitor origins
- Uncertainty on the size and scope of additional Federal stimulus with current stimulus ending at year-end
- Hawai'i indirect employment losses are kicking in for industries other than tourismrelated
- Major Hawai'i State and County revenue shortfalls will lead to compounding cuts
- Construction activity is slowing down
