



Richard Dahl is the next CEO of James Campbell Company



The James Campbell Company will welcome a new chief executive officer on August 11, when Richard Dahl steps in to succeed Board Chairman and CEO Steve MacMillan. Dahl is no stranger to Hawaii, as he spent more than 20 years at Bank of Hawaii Corp., including serving as its president and COO from 1994 to 2002.

“We are very pleased to have Richard Dahl join the James Campbell Company,” said MacMillan, who is retiring after more than 28 years with the Estate of James Campbell and now the James Campbell Company. “Richard has an impressive track record of success, both in Hawaii and the mainland. The board is confident that he is the right person to lead

the James Campbell Company to even greater success in the future.”

After his tenure at Bank of Hawaii, Dahl joined Dole Food Company, Inc., and became its president and COO. Dole, which was founded in Hawaii in 1851, is the largest fresh fruit and vegetable company in the world with about \$7 billion in revenues, operating in 94 countries, owning and leasing over 190,000 acres (including 26,000 in Hawaii), and employing over 75,000 people. Dahl is also currently the non-executive chairman of the Board of International Rectifier Corporation (NYSE:IRF) of El Segundo, California, and is a director of DineEquity, Inc. (NYSE:DIN) of Glendale, California and IDACORP, Inc. and Idaho Power Company, (NYSE:IDA) of Boise, Idaho.

In addition to directing the company’s real estate assets valued at more than \$2.6 billion and properties in Washington, D.C. and 16 states across the U.S., Dahl looks forward to overseeing the growth of the City of Kapolei.

“I remember when Kapolei was raw earth and a vision on the drawing board,” said Dahl. “It’s amazing to see how the city has developed and grown over the years, but it’s even more exciting
